The third element comprises of X-Com plug-in module, which can communicate with a variety of multi-vendor equipment for alarms and individual equipment control, thereby allowing operators to take control and diagnose status of each individual piece of equipment located either locally or at multi remote sites, which are linked via a LAN/WAN infrastructure.
